STUDIO COURSES TAUGHT

Photo One 207 - Basics in Black and White film photography using SLR 35mm cameras, darkroom techniques and history of photography. Modernist and Conceptual art explored.

Photography & New Media 221 - This beginning level *online* digital course is designed to provide the basic principles of photography and artistic expression through projects and exercises. Photography will be discussed and explored within an artistic context. Students may use any type of digital camera, including phones.

Advanced Photography 307- Students work using various formats and/or digital photography, continued advancement with darkroom techniques, develop understanding and making of conceptually-based photography.

Photo Imaging 104 - Art Introduction to using cameras and darkroom techniques. We begin with making photograms. The Holga camera is introduced as an experimental means to making images. Art making using cameras, scanning, blogs and video.

Intermedia Art 306 - Advanced level class exploring the avant-garde in 20th century art. Performance art using the body is our primary method of making art. Basic understanding of making video art will also be covered. Readings, videos and in-class discussions will give you the necessary framework to inspire your own work. A public Live Art night will be presented at the end of the block.

Women Make Their Mark; The Feminist Politics of Body Art - Special Topics Course for Women's Studies: The 1960's and 1970's were decades of enormous rebellion and change. Women were involved in both public and private battles to explore and expose traditional assumptions about gender, race, class, and especially sexuality. This course will examine and discuss the provocative body art work created and performed by women artists primarily during the 1960's and 1970's. There will be numerous and in-depth assigned readings, videos and slides pertaining to this work. You will be responsible for readings and assignments focused on making art using your body.

Experimental Drawing 103 & 203 - This class is an introduction to experimental drawing methods and ideas. Process and experimentation will be emphasized. Class work will develop and strengthen drawing skills and mark-making techniques. We will explore a wide variety of tools and media. It will be experimental in nature and focus on the spirit of creativity and process. Journal-making as art will be explored as well as collaborative drawing.
