If you're a member of Facebook, and you're logged in, you can even interact with us.

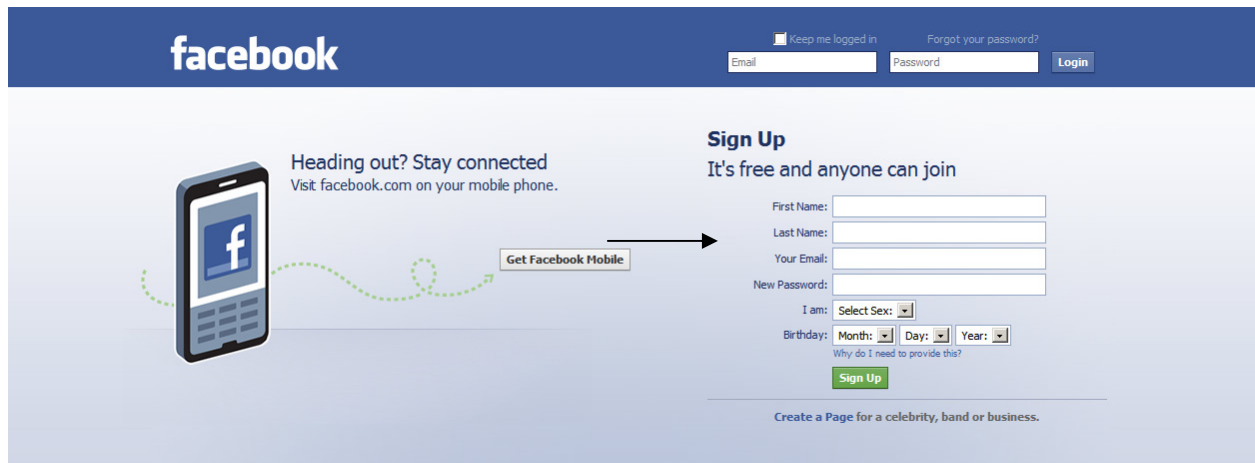
If you click the "Like" button—no pressure, but we like getting fans!—then when you visit Facebook, you'll see our news in your news feed, so you don't need to visit the page over and over again. Another advantage is that you can comment on the posts we make and even write things on our page to ask questions of other fans or just let us know some of the cool things you're up to.

We see a complete list of fans, but we can't see your profiles, so you're not endangering your privacy.

If you aren't a member, then you can still see what we do, you just can't post or comment.

If you think you'd like to join Facebook—and become a fan of the college—then here are a few steps to make it easier for you, and keep your information private.

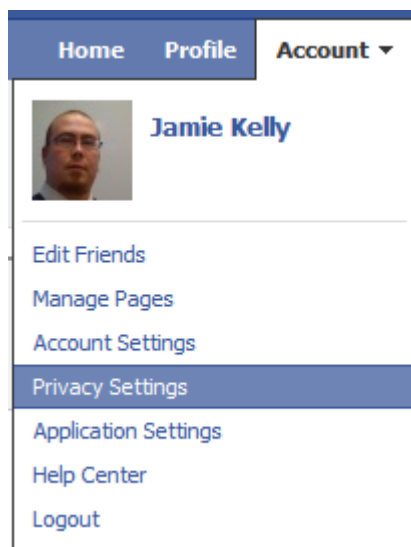
To join, visit <http://www.facebook.com> and fill in this form:



Then just follow the prompts and fill in your profile.

Here are some recommendations for privacy settings:

Click “Account” and choose “Privacy Settings”



That will bring up a list of links. You can choose what you'd like to be available to ANYONE, what you'd like to be available to just friends and what you're like no one to be able to see.

My suggestion is to make nearly everything available to just friends; that way you know who can see your information.
