## Disc Golf Liability Waiver Form

To the best of my knowledge, I am in good physical condition and fully able to participate in the Disc Golf course. I understand that there are several liability risks associated with participating in this activity such as (but not limited to) damage to a building or car, personal injury, injury to pedestrians who might walk through the course, etc. I agree to abide by the rules posted for this activity, including giving pedestrians the right of way. I voluntarily assume these risks and the associated financial costs, should damages occur.

I am fully aware of the risks and hazards connected with the participation in this event, including physical injury or even death, and hereby elect to voluntarily participate in said event, knowing that the associated physical activity may be hazardous to me and my property. I VOLUNTARILY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISKS OR LOSS, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR PERSONAL INJURY, that may be sustained by me, or loss or damage to property owned by me or by others, as a result of participation in this course. I understand that if any of the Cornell discs that I check out for my use from the college are lost or damaged, I am responsible for replacing them or will be charged \$20 per disc.

I hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue, Cornell College, the Campus Recreation office, their officers, servants, agents, and employees from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me, or to any property belonging to me, while participating in Disc Golf.

In signing, I acknowledge and represent that I HAVE READ THE FORGOING Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement, UNDERSTAND IT AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY as my own free act and deed; and I EXECUTE THIS RELEASE FOR FULL, ADEQUATE AND COMPLETE CONSIDERATION FULLY INTENDING TO BE BOUND BY SAME.

## Safety Rules & Policies

- Throw from designated areas; these have been specifically located for reasons of safety and challenge.
- Be sure the fairway is clear before throwing. Pedestrians have the right of way. Yell "fore" if a thrown disc is approaching a pedestrian.
- Do not hit lamp posts; impact can damage bulbs.
- Do not allow your discs to enter the street (this is a two-shot penalty).
- Pick up trash as you go, whether it is yours or not.
- The course is open only during daylight hours.
- Discs can be checked out from the Commons Information Desk. Lost or damaged discs cost \$20 to be replaced.
