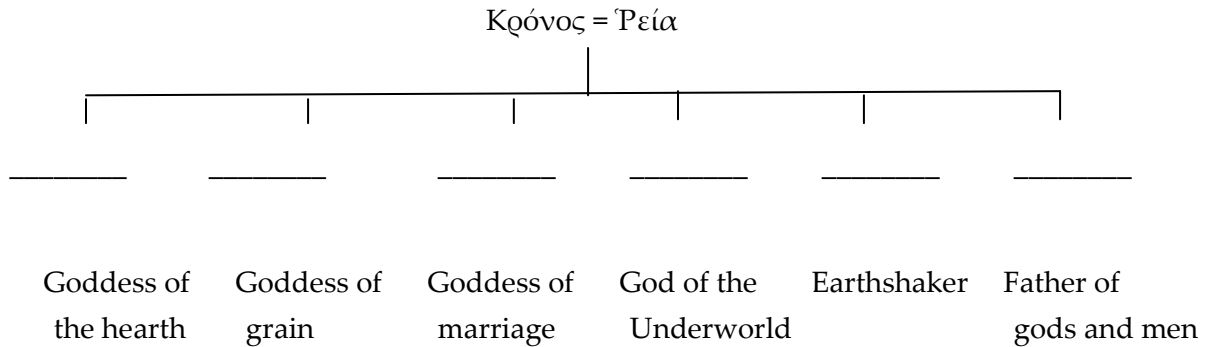
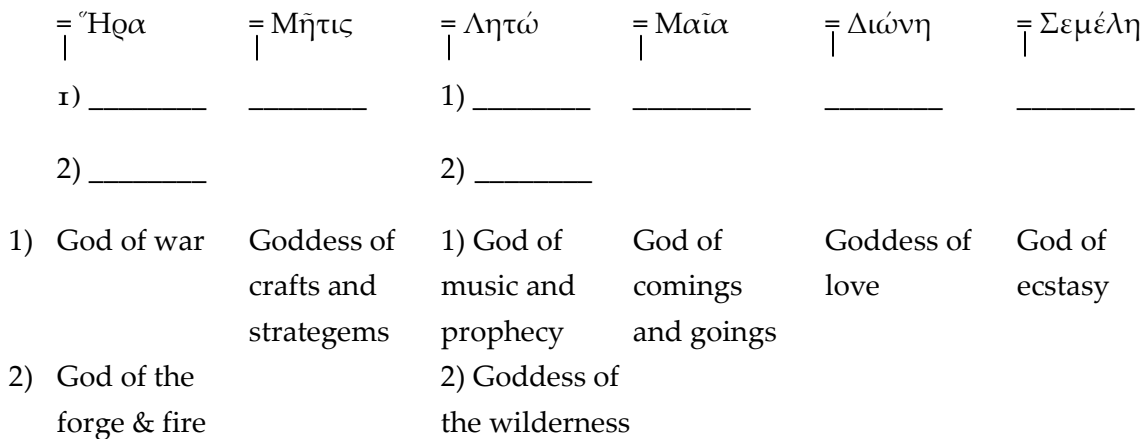

2. Matching gods with attributes. Draw a line from the god to the attributes that best characterize the god.

Ἀθηνᾶ	φιλομειδής, laughter loving; attendants: the Graces; attributes: girdle, seashell, mirror
Αἴδης	ἰοχέαιρα, arrow pouring, arrow showering symbols: bow and arrow, knee-high chiton
Ἀπόλλων	γλαυκῶπις bright eyed; sacred animal: owl; symbols: helmet, aegis with the head of the Gorgon Medusa
Ἄρης	ἔριούνιος helper; symbols: petasus (a flat traveler's hat), winged sandals, caduceus
Ἄρτεμις	κλυτοτέχνης famed for craftsmanship symbols: fire, pincers, anvil, hammer
Ἀφροδίτη	μαινόμενος frenzied; sacred animal: panther; symbols : wreath of ivy, thyrsus (staff wrapped with ivy topped with a pine cone)
Δημήτηρ	λευκώλενος white armed; sacred animal: peacock;
Διόνυσος	έκηβόλος shooting from afar; symbols: bow, lyre, tripod, laurel tree
Ἑρμῆς	ἐνοσίχθων γαιήοχος earth shaker: sacred animals: horse, dolphin; symbols: trident
Ἑστία	ἀδάμαστος inflexible, unconquerable symbol: helmet (of invisibility)
Ἥρα	νεφεληγερέτα cloud gatherer; sacred animal: eagle: symbol: thunderbolt
Ἥφαιστος	βροτολοιγός destroyer of men; symbol: spear
Ποσειδῶν	Symbol: hearth fire
Ζεὺς	ἀγλαόκαρπος* of bright fruit; symbols: ear of wheat
