*Cornell Fellows is the college's premier opportunity for high-level internships and professional mentoring; Fellows apply the liberal arts to the world.*

### **Program Goals and Outcomes**

---

- To enable Cornell Fellows to apply their liberal arts education to real-life situations.
  - Outcome: Cornell Fellows will be able to successfully complete a short-term project related to their academic and professional interests.
- To completely immerse Cornell Fellows in a workplace setting and in the culture of a potential career field.
  - Outcome: Cornell Fellows will be able to evaluate their career plans and to be prepared for realistic employment situations.
- To connect Cornell Fellows with professional mentors in their potential career field.
  - Outcome: Cornell Fellows will be able to develop an understanding of career paths that may contribute to their future vocations.

### **Cornell Fellows Overview**

---

- Fellowships are high-level internships offered around the United States and internationally; each Fellow is assigned a professional mentor at their site.
- Fellows complete a tangible project over an eight-week period; the experience encourages students to connect classroom theories to real-life applications.
- Fellows receive financial support (up to \$3,000 domestic, \$4,100 international) to offset expenses associated with housing, transportation, food, and supplies.
- Fellows must be enrolled at Cornell for the duration of the experience, and usually have achieved at least sophomore standing.
- Fellows come from all academic divisions of the College.
- Fellows blog throughout their experience; visit the CFP website!
- Fellowships are highly honorific; each fellowship is a named learning opportunity.
- Fellowships are available in one of three ways: applying for a CFP developed opportunity, proposing a research project in collaboration with a faculty member, or applying for funding after being selected for a competitive internship program.
- Fellowship applications are accepted on the third Friday of blocks one through eight.
- Fellows present their work at the end of each semester at the Cornell Fellows Showcase.
- Approximately 30 students are selected as Cornell Fellows each academic year.
- Nearly 130 students have completed fellowships since the program started in 2005.
