

2011 New Student Orientation Schedule-Parents Tuesday, Aug 30

If you are moving in first (student's last name between N-Z), proceed to your student's residence hall.

If you are going through Validation first (student's last name between A-M), proceed to one of these parking lots:
 Students who will reside in Dows, Tarr or Pfeiffer, park in the lot on 7th Ave SW or off College Blvd SW
 (behind the 10th Ave apartments)

Students who will reside in Bowman, Pauley, Rorem, Olin or Merner, park in the lot on 2nd St NW (behind
 Scott Alumni Center) or 1st Street W (beside the Multi-sport Center)

8:30 a.m. - noon	Move In When you arrive at your residence hall, Cornell staff and students will be available to help you find your way and move things from your vehicle to your room.
8:30 a.m. - noon	Validation (The Commons) For your convenience, most or all enrollment details can be handled in one place and in a short amount of time. We call it Validation. When you enter the Commons, you will receive a form identifying the various functions represented and pointing out which tables you need to visit.
11 a.m.	Campus tours (Kiosk behind Bowman Carter Hall) For those who have not previously had an opportunity to tour campus or who would like to review your student's new environment, this is an opportunity to have a guided tour and explore our campus.
11:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.	Lunch (The Commons, Sodexo) Students will receive 2 meal tickets for lunch while at Validation. Additional meal tickets are available for purchase at the door for \$7 each.
1 - 3 p.m.	Parent Orientation (Black Box Theatre in Armstrong Hall or Kimmel Theatre) Choose one location; the programs will essentially be the same in each as the facilitators rotate through the theatres to provide insight about academic and campus life, offer tips for success, and answer your questions. Presenters include the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Vice President for Student Affairs, Dean of Students, Assistant Dean/Director of Residence Life, and Director of the Career Engagement Center.
3:15 – 3:45 p.m.	Parent/Academic Advisor Info Session (Advisor Information and location will be provided to you at Validation) This is an opportunity for you to learn more about the advisory process and the relationship your student will establish with their advisor. You will meet with 3-4 advisors, one of whom is your student's advisor.
4 – 4:20 p.m.	New Student Convocation (College Hall Quad) This event is the official beginning of your student's Cornell experience. You will see the new students and faculty march together, and hear memorable comments from President Brand, Dean Dieker, and Father Quehl-Engel.
4:30 - 5:30 p.m.	Family Farewell
