8:30 a.m. – 12 noon	<b>Move In</b> When you arrive at your residence hall check-in location (see map), Cornell staff and students will be available to help you find your way and move things from your vehicle to your room.
8:30 a.m. – 12 noon	<b>Validation</b> (Thomas Commons) Mix and mingle with college administrators while your student is busy with Validation.
11 a.m.	<b>Campus Tours</b> (King Chapel) For those who have not previously had an opportunity to tour campus or who would like to review your student's new environment, this is an opportunity to have a guided tour and explore our campus
11:00-12:15 p.m. or 1:45-3 p.m.	<b>Academic &amp; Student Life Info Session</b> (Kimmel Theatre) Presenters provide insight about academic and campus life, offer tips for success, and answer your questions. Presenters include the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Vice President for Student Affairs, Dean of Students, and Assistant Dean/Director of Residence Life.
11:30 a.m. – 1 p.m.	<b>Lunch</b> (Thomas Commons, Hilltop Dining) Students will receive 2 meal tickets for lunch while at Validation. Additional meal tickets are available for purchase at the door.
3:15-3:45 p.m.	<b>Meet Your Student's Advisor</b> (Advisor Information and location will be provided to you at Validation) This is an opportunity for you to learn more about the advisory process and the relationship your student will establish with their advisor. You will meet with 3-4 advisors, one of whom is your student's advisor
4 – 4:20 p.m.	<b>New Student Convocation</b> (Outside College Hall, Rain Location: King Chapel) This event is the official beginning of your student's Cornell experience. You will see the new students and faculty march together, and hear memorable comments from President Brand, Dean Dieker, and Father Quehl-Engel
