Fulbright Grant Program

Eligibility: US Citizen, completed BA (or equivalent), interest in studying/teaching/research abroad

Deadline: Early October (Applicants are advised to start their application at least 2 months prior to the deadline)

Boren Fellowship

Up to \$20,000 funding for an international study experience in an underrepresented region (Africa, Central/Eastern Europe, Middle East, etc.)

Eligibility: US Citizen, enrolled in an accredited graduate program

Deadline: Late January

Rhodes Scholarship (Oxford University)

Provides full funding for 2 years of graduate study at Oxford.

Eligibility: completed BA, strong academic standing

Deadline: October (Applicants are advised to start their application at least 2 months prior)

Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship

Eligibility: Pell Grant recipients applying for an international program lasting 4+ weeks (summer-only programs excluded)

Deadline: April (fall); October (spring)

Provides funding for 3, 6, or 9-month international study opportunities

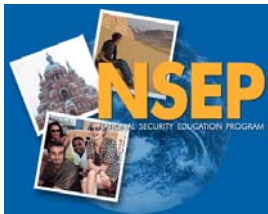
NSEP Boren Scholarship

Up to \$20,000 funding for an international study experience in an underrepresented region (Africa, Central/Eastern Europe, Middle East, etc.) critical to US interests

Eligibility: US Citizen, enrolled in an accredited undergraduate institution

Deadline: February

DAAD Undergraduate Scholarship (Germany)

Eligibility: US Citizen, Junior/Senior, study/research/intern program for 4-10 months in Germany (German proficiency not required)

Deadline: January

Eligibility: Undergraduate student studying in Japan for 3-10 months

Deadline: Varies (must work through Japanese university)
