Athenaze, Chapter 3b

EN APXH ἦν ὁ λόγος, καὶ ὁ λόγος ἦν πρὸς τὸν θεόν, καὶ θεὸς ἦν ὁ λόγος.

[2] Οὗτος ἦν ἐν ἀρχῇ πρὸς τὸν θεόν.

Vocabulary:

ἀρχή, ἡ, beginning

ἦν was (past tense of εἰμί)

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[19] Μὴ θησαυρίζετε ὑμῖν θησαυροὺς ἐπὶ τῆς γῆς, ὅπου σὴς καὶ βρῶσις ἀφανίζει, καὶ ὅπου κλέπται διορύσσουσιν καὶ κλέπτουσιν:

[20] θησαυρίζετε δὲ ὑμῖν θησαυροὺς ἐν οὐρανῶ, ὅπου οὔτε σὴς οὔτε βρῶσις ἀφανίζει, καὶ ὅπου κλέπται οὐ διορύσσουσιν οὐδὲ κλέπτουσιν:

[21] ὅπου γὰρ ἐστὶν ὁ θησαυρὸς σου, ἐκεῖ ἔσται [καὶ] ἡ καρδία σου.

σὴς, ὁ, a moth

βρῶσις, ἡ, corrosion, rust

διορύσσω to dig through
