

Dean's Advisory Council

a) Purpose

- (1) To provide regular advice and consultation to the Dean of the College and Vice-President of Academic Affairs regarding planning, scheduling, and other matters of concern to the faculty.

b) Functions

- (1) Meets with the Dean regularly to discuss upcoming faculty or administrative initiatives and events. The Dean's Advisory Council is not a voting body and does not pass legislation to be considered by the full faculty.

c) Members

- (1) Regular membership consists of the Faculty Council Chair, the Faculty Council Vice-Chair, the Chair of Divisional Council, and the untenured faculty representative to Faculty Council.
- (2) Other major committee chairs may be invited by the Dean to participate to discuss matters relevant to their committees.
