My signature below indicates that I understand and agree to the following:

- The S/SD/NC option is **NOT** pass/fail. It is Satisfactory, Satisfactory - D, and No Credit. Satisfactory (S) is given in place of a letter grade of C- or above; Satisfactory - D (SD) is given in place of a letter grade of **D+, D, or D-**. Grades of S or SD ensure credit toward graduation but do not affect a student's grade-point average.
- No Credit (NC) is given in place of a letter grade of **F**. A grade of NC does not confer credit, nor does it affect a student's grade-point average.
- This form, properly filled out and signed, must be emailed to the Registrar's Office at registrar@cornellcollege.edu anytime during the block until 4:00pm on the 15th day of the block.
- **On the 15th day of the block (between 8:30am-4:00pm) you may email the Registrar's Office at registrar@cornellcollege.edu and tell us you wish to remove the S/SD/NC option. You will receive a letter grade instead. The S/SD/NC option CANNOT be removed or changed to a letter grade at any other time.**
- Students may use this option 4 times during their Cornell career*. This includes previous uses of the former S/U option, so students may have a total of 4 S/SD/U/NC on their transcript.
- See the [Catalogue](#) for specific regulations and procedures concerning the S/SD/NC option. Not all courses are eligible for this option. The course description will note if a course is not eligible for an alternate grade.

*Blocks 7 and 8 of 2020 are the exception. S/Us during those blocks do not count toward any total or maximum.
