

GROUP PROJECT CONTRACT

- To receive course credit for a Group Project, this form must be completed, signed by each participating student, faculty sponsor, and department chair, and returned to the Registrar's Office *at least one week prior to the block in which the project is to begin.*
- Group Projects are open only to students who have completed at least eight term credits.
- Please note that a maximum of four course credits earned in Individual Projects, Group Projects, Internships, and Summer Study may be counted toward the minimum 31 credits required for the B.A. or B.Mus. degree. A maximum of two course credits in these areas may be counted toward the eight course credits required at the 300 level for the B.A. or B.Mus. degree.
- Consult the *Cornell College Catalogue* ("All-College Independent Study Courses") for general requirements, policies, and limits governing credit for Group Projects.
- Only students who have signed the original petition are eligible to receive credit for this Group Project.
- Group Projects are graded only *Credit/No Credit*.
