Original Project Definition:

Students may do intensive work in close supervision of a faculty member in which the outcome is a substantial project that involves original work (e.g., research, synthesis paper, work of art, or composition). Original projects must involve NEW work. It must produce a new, creative project or create research that makes a new contribution to a field of study.

- **Credit limits:** A maximum of four credits earned in Independent Credit Bearing Courses may be counted toward the 31 credits required to graduate. Note: **credit will not be approved retroactively for any independent courses.**
