- Unsatisfactory (U) is given in place of a letter grade of C- or below. No credit will be earned for the course and it will NOT count towards the degree or the major/minor. If the course is needed as a prerequisite for a future course, an Unsatisfactory will not allow you to move forward in course sequence.
- This form, properly filled out and signed, must be returned to the Registrar’s Office before 4:00pm on the 3rd day of the block.
- On the 15th day of the block (between 8:30am-4:00pm) you can come to the Registrar’s Office in person and elect to remove the S/U option and have a letter grade instead (sign box below). The S/U option can NOT be removed or changed to a letter grade at any other time.
