Apartment Descriptions

The 10th Avenue Apartments are located on 10th Avenue South, near the soccer practice fields. The 10th Avenue complex is made up of one building consisting of two mirror image, two-story duplexes. Eight students live in each side. Each side has five bedrooms (1 triple, 1 double and 3 singles) and a common living room, kitchen and bathroom. The College provides furniture in each bedroom at the 10th Avenue Apartments; however, the College does not provide common area furniture.

Although, all students can participate in the 10th Avenue Apartment lottery, preference will be given to those students who commit to living substance free. Students desiring substance free living will be asked to fill out a *substance free living contract* when they submit their lottery form on April 9.

10th Avenue Apartments are connected to the campus network.

Residents selected to live in the 10th Avenue Apartments may opt for a full or partial meal plan.

Eligibility

All students returning to Cornell in the fall are eligible to sign up for housing in the 10th Avenue Apartments. Apartment living offers a more independent living option for students and requires a high level of maturity. Therefore, apartment living is not made available to students whose disciplinary records indicate they are not ready for this living option. Generally, this means no conduct violations for the past year.

Selection Process

Each group of eight people (males, females, or co-ed with single sex rooms) must complete the information below. Apartments will be granted to the groups with the highest total number of points (based on projected class standing at the end of Term Nine: 3 points for each senior, 2 points for each junior, and 1 point for each sophomore). Each group will draw a number in case there is a tie for points (lowest number is best). The groups who will be living in the apartments next year will be notified by e-mail.

By signing below, I acknowledge and accept that the Cornell College Tenth Avenue Apartments are designated as substance free student housing. Substance free housing is defined as a living environment in which residents and visitors, regardless of their age, abstain from the use of alcohol. Exposing residents living in substance free housing to secondary effects of such usage, (i.e. noise, vandalism and messes resulting from the use of a substance) is also prohibited.

In addition to those substances normally prohibited on campus, I agree **not to possess** alcoholic beverages, or alcohol beverage containers on the premises (this includes the grounds surrounding the building). As is the case with all campus buildings, smoking is not permitted. I understand that violating this agreement will result in up to a \$250 fine, and any subsequent policy violation will result in doubling of fines and/or my relocation to other college housing, or removal from campus.
